ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Uses computer-aided drafting (CAD) software to create full-scale and detailed drawings of the means & methods at various stages of the construction project designs of all parts of the tunnel project. This shall be based on principles and rough drawings prepared by the means & methods engineer, and incorporate construction regulations (such as lifting rules)
- Identifies and proposes solutions to enhance safety, work around existing site constraints, keep the means & methods solution within the project's right-of-way and prefer means that can easily be mobilized locally.
- Prepares preliminary drawings for internal purposes and reviews to allow for a fast-paced solutions' assessment, selection and optimization.
